the sum of Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars, 5<sup>th</sup> we give devise  
bequeath to our Son Stephan Flachac the sum of Two Hundred  
(\$200) Dollars, after our death if there is anything more left  
after all this payments, then said Mathias Flachac (Jr.)  
shall have it. We hereby nominate and appoint our Son  
said Mathias Flachac, the executor of this our last will  
and testament, and hereby authorize and empower him:  
the said Mathias Flachac, to compound, compromise  
and settle any claim or demand which may be against
